- A long-term commitment and loyal dedication to the Saint Paul Winter Carnival and its success.
- Recognizes that producing the Saint Paul Winter Carnival is serious business but has never taken their role or effort so seriously that they make it difficult for others to remain enthusiastic about their involvement.
- An ability to multiply their own contributions by leading others to contribute to the Saint Paul Winter Carnival as volunteers and supporters.
- Recognizes that the Saint Paul Winter Carnival can continually be improved and has worked in a spirit of cooperation from within to help make the Saint Paul Winter Carnival a continued success.
- Demonstration of their commitment to the wider community through community involvement and support <u>outside</u> the Saint Paul Winter Carnival.
