Judging Criteria

The Sal and Francesca (Corky) LoBaido Volunteer Service Award will be presented to an individual(s) who best meet the spirit of commitment and volunteerism that was displayed by Sal and Corky LoBaido. In making their decision, the judges will consider the following characteristics of the nominated volunteer:

- A long-term commitment and loyal dedication to the Saint Paul Winter Carnival, who has been more interested in seeing the Saint Paul Winter Carnival succeed than in taking credit for that success.
- Recognizes that producing the Saint Paul Winter Carnival is serious business but has never taken their role as a volunteer or their effort so seriously that they make it difficult for others to remain enthusiastic about their involvement.
- An ability to multiply their own contributions by leading others to contribute to the Saint Paul Winter Carnival as volunteers.
- Recognizes that the Saint Paul Winter Carnival can continually be improved and has worked in a spirit of cooperation from within to help make the Saint Paul Winter Carnival a continued success.
- Demonstration of their commitment to the community in which they live through volunteer activities outside the Saint Paul Winter Carnival.
